

## 2015 Update: Our impact in UDICC, Haiti



In UDICC, a tree nursery is providing the community with nutritious food. There are many challenges in this community including getting access to good, healthy food. Many families are farmers but their production is very low and they don't produce enough to eat and have little income to meet their family's basic needs.

World Vision introduced a tree nursery in the community, allowing easy access to a great variety of fruit and forest trees. "We are able to sell the fruits and give some to the kids to eat," said Luvana, mother of three. Young Newevens often visits to help his mother at the nursery.

World Vision is also working with the community to establish family gardens so they can grow more vegetables and raise small animals as well as teaching mothers how to cook nutritious meals.

**912 farmers** were trained in updated crop production techniques and livestock management to help meet their family needs.



**1,213 local leaders** have learned about children's rights in order to make the community a safer place for children.



**1,200 people** learned conservation methods to ensure their environment is preserved and their families have food year-round.
